

Four Year Plan

What is a 4 year plan? It is a general idea of what the student will want to take in high school. It gives students a guideline for what is required for certain programs of study. It is required by the state of Idaho for graduation.

What a 4 year plan is NOT: It is not a schedule. It is not set in stone. Students may not want to follow the pathway exactly as it appears. For example, students may want to take some honors classes instead of the regular classes listed on the 4 year plan. Students may change their minds and choose a completely different pathway. The student's log in is good for all 4 years, so students may want to update and change what they have on the plan (though that is not required).

Directions for parents:

Go to idahocis.org

Log in with the student's log in (they will know it)—Two digit year the student will graduate, first 3 letters of first name, and full last name (21JanSmith)

Password: Student's lunch number followed by psD. (123456psD). Capitalize the D.

Click on Portfolio in the top right hand corner of the screen. Go to the third item under Portfolio "How do I plan my courses?" Click on the plus sign and then on the little writing tablet.
