Code of Conduct

1. Good citizenship as well as being respectful to teachers and peers is expected (no profanity, illegal tactics, etc.).
2. If you quit an activity, two weeks after the start date, you may not be able to participate in other activities the rest of the school year. It is important to finish what you start.
3. You will be held responsible for your uniform and equipment. You will be required to pay for any lost or damaged items.
4. While involved in the activity, you must be in attendance the majority of the school day to participate (practice or games).
5. All participants must travel to and from out of town contests in school provided transportation. Students may return home from out of town contests with only their parent/guardian. The adult must sign their child out with the coach.
6. You may be drug tested at any time during the school year.
7. All participants must have:
 - A) A current medical information and permission for treatment form on file.
 - B) A current physical on file
 - C) School insurance or proof of insurance on file
 - D) Passed (5) five classes the previous quarter
 - E) Purchase a current Activity Card
8. You may not use or be in possession of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco. All participants must not violate misdemeanor or felony statutes of the State of Idaho. Violations may be handled as follows:
 - 1st Offense: suspension from extra curricular contests for 1 week. The student will still attend practices during the 1 week ban from competition.
 - 2nd Offense: suspension from extra curricular activity 45 days or the season, which ever is longer. This may carry over into the next season. The days between seasons will not count towards the suspension.
 - 3rd Offense: suspension from extra curricular activities for 60 days. This may carry over into the next season. The days between the seasons will not count toward the suspension. The suspension may roll over from one year to the next.
9. The coach and/or principal shall resolve any issue not covered by this code.

These are the minimum requirements. Coaches may publish and distribute stronger and/or additional guidelines upon administration approval.

Chain of Command Procedure Guidelines

If you wish to pursue a complaint, you must follow the Chain of Command Procedure. It is mandatory to follow this procedure for action to be initiated.

Chain of Command Procedure

Level 1: Meet with the Coach/Advisor*

Level 2: Meet with the building Administrator*

Level 3: Meet with the Superintendent*

Level 4: Meet with the Board of Trustees

** If satisfaction has not been met, proceed to the next level.*
