- Five-year federal grant enables us to provide all day kindergarten.
- Your child will have two different teachers, one in the morning and the other in the afternoon.
- General education teachers will focus on academic instruction. They will do grade level testing, provide homework, report cards and schedule parent teacher conferences.
- 21st "grant" teachers will provide academic enrichment activities; including science, and social studies units. They will take students to the Payette Public Library monthly and on community field trips.
