<p>Hire Coaches</p>	<p>Motion was made by Greg Kelley and seconded by Jessica Lowry to hire Mr. Carl Keever as the Payette High School head football coach and authorize the early release of funds from the contract value to cover relocation costs, hire Dan Kauvaka PHS assistant football coach and hire Ken Nakis PHS assistant football coach. 	<p>Chairman La Mue asked for an update on the PHS boys basketball coach position. Mr. Schultz did not accept the head coach position when offered by PHS Principal Mark Heleker. Mr. Schultz is completing the summer basketball schedule and will be compensated for those duties in August. The open position for head boys basketball coach is still posted.</p> <p>PHS head girls basketball coach Mr. Tory Bratcher has recommended Lacey Watson-LaPierre for the PHS assistant girls basketball coach position. Motion was made by Jessica Lowry and seconded by Greg Kelley to hire Ms. Watson-LaPierre. Motion carried unanimously.</p>
