



MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 371J, PAYETTE AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES, IDAHO, OCTOBER 23, 2013 AT 8:30 A.M., IN THE PAYETTE SCHOOL DISTRICT OFFICE.

<p>Correct Policy Number 803.14 to 806.1</p> <p>Executive Session</p>	<p>Chairman Gary La Mue called the meeting to order in the Payette School District Office at 8:30 A.M. with Board members Greg Kelley, Jessica Lowry, Mona Points and Adam Rynearson present.</p> <p>Clerk Choate asked Chairman La Mue to amend the agenda to include a correction to the policy number of the Retention Policy that was adopted at the October 14th, 2013 Board meeting. Motion was made by Mona Points and seconded by Jessica Lowry to correct the policy number of the retention policy from 803.14 to 806.1. No other changes were made to the retention policy. Motion carried unanimously.</p> <p>Barbara Choate read: "Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of School District 371J Payette, Idaho, as provided in Section 67-2345 (1) (b) of the Idaho Code, the Board will now go into executive session at 8:35 A.M. for the purpose of two expulsion hearings and a student request to re-enroll after expulsion. Motion is therefore made by Mona Points and seconded by Jessica Lowry that Payette School Board go into executive session." Voting yes: Gary La Mue, Jessica Lowry, Mona Points, Adam Rynearson and Greg Kelley. Voting no: No one</p> <p>The Board was declared out of executive session at 9:17 A.M.</p> <p>Motion was made by Greg Kelley and seconded by Mona Points to not expel Student "A". Student will be allowed to continue enrollment in classes based on compliance with a behavior contract that includes no classroom disruptions, grades and attendance mandates. In-school suspension will continue during the lunch hour through December 2, 2013. Motion carried unanimously.</p> <p>Motion was made by Mona Points and seconded by Jessica Lowry to expel Student "B" for the remainder of the 2013-2014 school year. Student can request re-enrollment for the 2014-2015 only if sufficient online school or PASS credits have been successfully completed. Motion carried unanimously.</p> <p>Motion was made by Adam Rynearson and seconded by Mona Points allow Student "C" to enroll in the Payette Alternative Center only because it is required by federal law. Student will be restricted to the Payette Alternative Center campus and not allowed on any other school property. Student will be placed on a strict behavior contract to include being required to submit to a "pat down" on a daily basis, a back pack will not be allowed in the school or on the bus and external counseling must continue. Proof of counseling to be submitted to Payette Alternative Center administration upon request.
